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Ashley Infinity Scarf



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A one-skein pattern to make a colorful and pretty accessory for your wardrobe!

Finished size: 6" x 40" (approximate)

Supplies Needed

- 1-100g skein ColorNotes worsted weight yarn
 - Willow Glen Worsted
 - Tahoe

Sample made with Tahoe yarn in Ashley colorway
- Size 8 needles, straight or circular
- Tapestry needle

Note: pattern includes 2 stitch garter edge on both long sides of scarf.

Cast on 32 stitches

Pattern

Row 1: k3, *ssk, k9, k2tog; repeat from * to last 3 stitches, k3

Row 2: k2, purl to last 2 stitches, k2

Row 3: k3, *ssk, k7, k2tog; repeat from * to last 3 stitches, k3.

Row 4: k2, purl to last 2 stitches, k2

Row 5: k3, *ssk, yo [k1,yo] 5 times, k2tog; repeat from * to last stitch, k3

Row 6: Knit

Repeat rows 1-6 until about 16" of yarn is left, ending on row 6. Cast off all stitches; do not cut tail.

Finishing

The scarf ends are attached by whip stitching the 2 ends together using the long tail left from the cast off stitches. Bring the 2 short ends of the scarf together, with right sides facing. Attach a tapestry needle to the long tail and whip stitch ends together. Weave in ends, block if necessary, and enjoy!
