



Dominica Shawl

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An easy one-skein knitted shawl with a beautiful lace pattern and extra wide wingspan to fall gracefully around the neck and shoulders.

Skill Type: Knitting

Skill Level: Easy

Skills Needed: Knit, purl, yarn over, increases, decreases.

Finished Measurements (inches)

Length: 15"

Wingspan: 54"



Materials

- Color Notes Yarn Pure Worsted (100g, 218 yds, 100% Merino NSW) [CYCA 4], 1 skein in Berry (shown above) or color of your choice.
- U.S. 8 [5.0 mm] 32" circular needle
- Stitch markers or scrap yarn
- Tapestry needle

Gauge is not critical for this project.

Pattern Notes

- Shawl is knitted from the bottom up, with increases on both ends on every row
- Design includes a 2-stitch garter edge, worked by knitting the first two and last two stitches of every row

Lace Pattern Stitch

(Multiple of 8 stitches and 10 rows). See stitch chart on page 3.

Row 1 (RS): k1, ssk, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, k2tog.

Row 2 and all WS Rows: purl.

Row 3: rep row 1

Row 5: k1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo.

Row 7: k2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1.

Row 9: k3, yo, s2kp, yo, k2.

Repeat rows 1-10 for pattern.

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INSTRUCTIONS

SHAWL

Using U.S. 8 needle, cast on 5 stitches using a crochet hook, or your favorite method.

Row 1 (RS): k2, yo, k1, yo, k2.

Row 2: k2, yo, k3, yo, k2.

Row 3: k2, yo, k5, yo, k2.

Row 4: k2, yo, k7, yo, k2.

Rows 5-44: Begin working lace pattern following stitch chart on page 3, maintaining the 2-stitch garter edge at each end by knitting the first two and last two stitches of every row.

Note: Edge stitches are not included on the chart.

Rows 45-84: repeat rows 5-44.

Rows 85-86: knit.

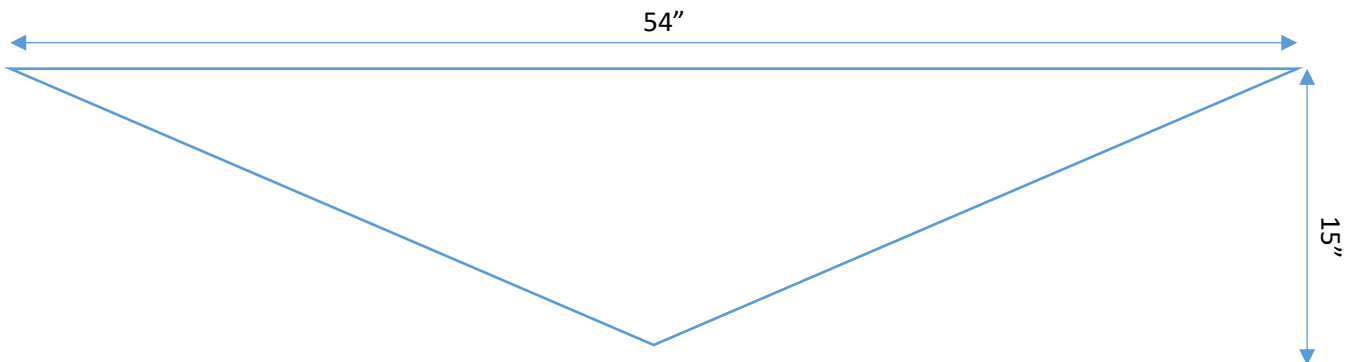
Row 87 (WS): BO all stitches knitwise.

FINISHING

Steam or wet block to measurements.

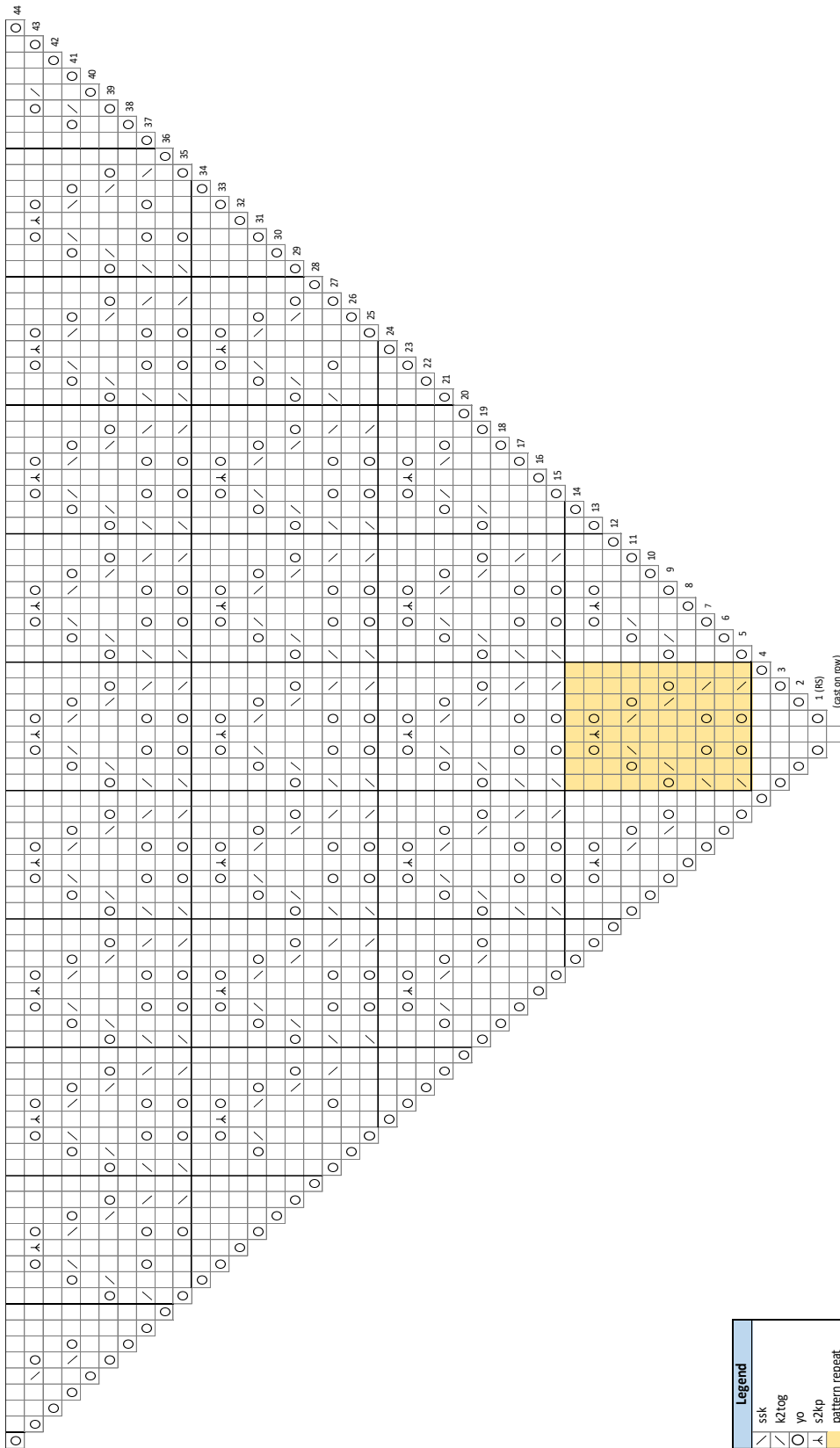
Weave in ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS

*	repeat the instructions between asterisks as many times as directed or repeat from a given set of instructions
"	inches
beg	begin/beginning
CYCA	Craft Yarn Council of America
k	knit
k2tog	knit two stitches together (right leaning decrease)
mm	millimeter
p	purl
rep	repeat
RS	right side
s2kp	Slip 2 stitches knitwise, knit 1, pass slipped stitches over (centered double decrease)
ssk	Slip, slip, knit (left leaning decrease)
st(s)	stitch(es)
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows)
tog	together
WS	wrong side
yo	yarn over
